

Gradebook Integration

Audience: Website Administrators

SchoolFusion is able display many gradebooks for no additional charge.

Examples are:

- InteGrade Pro
- GradeBuster
- EasyGradePro
- Chancery eClass Grades

There are two options to complete gradebook integration: Teacher Upload or District FTP.

Option 1: Teacher Upload

Currently, there are several gradebooks that are routinely uploaded by TEACHERS into SchoolFusion. This includes:

- GradeBuster files (These files are uploaded and displayed within their framework)
- EasyGrade Pro files (both XML and Basmati*)
- Any grade book program that can export Basmati* XML files such as GradeKeeper and Chancery eClass Grades (using the SchoolFusion export filter)

Note: *Basmati is a specific XML-based gradebook format. It is limited and cannot by definition contain assignment category information.

Option 2: District FTP

Gradebook data can be uploaded by the SCHOOL DISTRICT via FTP or SFTP.

1. SchoolFusion creates an FTP or SFTP account for the school district.
2. The school district will FTP the gradebook information for import to SchoolFusion.
3. Currently, SchoolFusion processes the information below through an automated process once a day:
 - a. InteGrade Pro dBase files.
 - b. Exported gradebook data as tab-separated (or CSV) text files.

Please Note: If you wish to upload grades through the FTP, this process this will require the purchase of the SchoolFusion Student Information Center. Please see the HelpCenter > Data > Student Information Center for more details.

NOTE: The GradeBuster gradebook data is self-contained and the information does not need to correspond to any data in SchoolFusion. For all other gradebooks, the teacher and student IDs used in the gradebook must be the same as their corresponding IDs in SchoolFusion, or that particular teacher's classes or student's assignments/grades will not be imported.

In keeping with our motto of "If you can export it, we can import it", we do our best to accommodate the import of all gradebooks. If you have a gradebook system that is not mentioned above, it may be possible for an integration to be built. Depending on the system, and integration efforts, there could be a minimal charge. In order for a gradebook to be imported, the data files or data exports need to be available for import. This data can be in the form of XML files, tab or CSV text files, Excel files, and dBase files, depending on the gradebook.
